Repository Hosting Service Agreement between LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ and CLARIN.SI

This Agreement is made between:

1 the Czech research infrastructure LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ, Charles University, Prague, Czech Republic, located at Malostranské nám. 25, 11800 Prague 1, Czech Republic represented by prof. Jan Hajič;

and

2 the Slovenian research infrastructure CLARIN.SI, Jožef Stefan Institute, Ljubljana, Slovenia, located at Jamova cesta 39, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, represented by prof. Tomaž Erjavec.

1. PURPOSE & SCOPE

1.1. The purpose of this Agreement is further strengthen the continuity of access of the LINDAT/ CLARIAH-CZ and CLARIN.SI repositories of language resources and tools by undertaking to host the resources of the other infrastructure repository in case of termination of its funding, which would prevent the original repository from further hosting its resources.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1. Both parties to this Agreement use the open source CLARIN DSpace platform for their repositories of language resources and tools, with LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ being the main developer of this open source software. Both parties also have stable funding for their work on, inter alia, maintaining the repository and overseeing the addition of new entries. Nevertheless, due to unforeseen circumstances, the funding for either repository could be cancelled in the future. The fact that the two repositories use the same platform allows for simple migration of all the data from one CLARIN DSpace repository to another while keeping the records accessible under the same PIDs and with the exact same feature set. Thus if the funding for one of the two infrastructure would be terminated completely, the other infrastructure would be able to host the data of the terminated infrastructure and to reconfigure its permanent identifiers for the data.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1. The infrastructure that would have its funding terminated will allow full access to its repository data, metadata and permanent identifier configuration to the infrastructure that retains its funding.

- 3.2. The infrastructure that retains its funding will ingest the data and metadata and reconfigure the permanent identifiers to point to the new locations of the repository items.
- 3.3. In case both infrastructures have their funding terminated, this Agreement in null and void.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE AND SIGNATURE

- 4.1. This Agreement shall be effective upon the date of the last party to sign it below. The parties indicate their agreement by their signatures below.
- 4.2. Any changes to this Agreement have to be made in writing, and signed by both parties.
- 4.3. This Agreement is made in two copies, with each party receiving one signed copy.
